Prevalence:

- SJMC hospital was established in 1975. It is part of St. John's National Academy of Health Sciences run by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of India
- SJMC hospital is a tertiary care teaching hospital equipped with Laboratories, blood bank and other facilities, with a total bed strength of 1200.
- Plastic surgery & burns department --
- Annual Inpatients / Outpatients : 150 – 170 inpatients. 400 outpatients
- Burn surgeries: 300-400 every year

Infrastructure:

- SJMC burn unit consists of 6+6 burn beds
- Workforce consist of 13 surgeons, 7 of whom are consultants.
- There are 3 trained people to do dressings.
- The nurse to patient ratio is 1:3
- Ancillary departments: Physio and occupational therapy, counsellors and nutrition

Treatment protocol:

1. Primary survey
2. Fluid resuscitation and monitoring
3. Regular wound assessments and dressings
4. Surgery as required, including early tangential excision and skin cover
5. Nutrition
6. Physiotherapy
7. Follow up in the out patient department
